

The Salvation Army Kroc Center Aquatic Rules:

1. Aquatic Center is permitted only when a lifeguard is on duty.
2. Obey the lifeguards at all times.
3. No Running.
4. Absolutely no jumping or diving in the pool is permitted.
5. Shower before entering pool.
6. **An adult 16 years or older must accompany children under the age of 10. Children 5 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water at all times.**
7. **Absolutely no cotton is allowed in the pool.**
8. Approved swimsuits only. Males must have a drawstring and a liner in their swimsuits. Females may not wear any street clothes, thong suits, and bathing suits with metal ornamentations on them. **Infants and toddlers must have on an appropriate swim diaper and plastic pant covering.**
9. Anyone with open sores or contagious sores is not permitted in the pool.
10. Absolutely no glass is permitted in the pool area.
11. No hanging on lane lines or lane markers.
12. Only toys that are permitted by pool staff are allowed in the pool. **Water guns or squirt guns are not allowed.**
13. **Must be 48" tall to go down the slide.**
14. **10-Minute Rule:** At the top of every hour you will hear the lifeguards blow their whistles. At this time all children under the age of 16 must exit the pool. This time is for children to take a restroom break and will be reserved for adult swim only. 10 minutes after the hour the whistle will sound again indicating that children may reenter the pool.
15. No food or drinks are allowed in the pool area.
